Plans for the 2022 Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic are underway! PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR COUNTY OR 4-H ASSOCIATION IS AWARE OF THE CHANGES BELOW. The pre-registration forms are for out-of-province participants.

#### **\*\*HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2022 \*\***

- 2022 marks the 41<sup>ST</sup> show of the Classic! We welcome you back as we celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair. You will be seeing lots of activity on the Classic Facebook page and other social media to help mark this milestone. We highly encourage everyone to post their "royal memories" in the form of pictures, videos, etc. from the past or present to <https://www.facebook.com/td4hclassic/>. So, find those memories to share from the last 100 years!
- **NEW STABLING** is being installed in the barns that may affect your display. Information and photos will be shared once details are confirmed.
- There will be **no bus services provided** during the 2022 TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic. Each team will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the RAWF.
- Two Chaperones per team are required - in compliance with the guidelines of 4-H Canada, all county/regional/provincial teams at the 2022 TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic must have two (2) chaperones present during the show. Entrance passes/wristbands for two will be provided for entry into the show grounds.
- Hotels - Teams are responsible for arranging their own accommodations.
- Code of Conduct – The Code of Conduct must be signed and submitted by all those participating in the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic prior to attending the 2022 TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic. Both chaperones must sign and submit the Chaperone agreement.

#### **\*\*Also Please Note\*\*:**

- Entry fee is \$25 for all youth livestock exhibitors.
- To comply with ProAction requirements for Identification and Traceability, **all calves of all breeds must be tagged** with dairy breed sanctioned National tags (NLID).
- Only 1 (one) project per 4-H member may be pre-registered for the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic.
- Team displays and animal move-in will begin at 6 am on Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup>. Veterinarians will be in place to perform the health inspections of calves.

- Showmanship Competition will be on Monday, November 7<sup>th</sup> from 2 – 10 pm; Conformation on Tuesday, November 8<sup>th</sup> from 8 am – 4:30 pm.
- The Royal has eliminated the rule restricting a 4-H member from competing in only one Junior Livestock (Bovine) Show at the 2022 RAWF. However, move-in and move-out dates/times must be adhered to for both events, respectively.
- It will not be necessary to bring an animal's registration papers to the show this year; however, all project animals must be registered with their respective breed association and meet purity level requirements.

### Pre-registration Guidelines

**Every potential 4-H member (other than Ontario) that may be interested in competing in the 2022 TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair in November must complete PRE-REGISTRATION.** The procedure is as follows:

#### **All Provinces (EXCLUDING Ontario):**

- The Provincial TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic Coordinator or the Provincial 4-H Supervisor will provide the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic Committee with a listing of all bonafide 4-H calves and members with a 2022 4-H Dairy Calf project.
- Quebec, please separate and clearly mark each of the six designated regions.
- A Pre-Registration Form is attached for out-of-province. If more convenient, you may provide a copy of the registration form that is used to register 4-H projects in your province. All Pre-Registration forms must be forwarded to the Ontario Holstein Branch **by June 15th, 2022**. Please send all completed pre-registration forms from your province, region, district or county in one envelope. - Only one (1) calf project per 4-H member may be pre-registered.

#### **In Ontario**

- Ontario 4-H Dairy members must complete their Dairy Online entries to register their calf by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 via Assist Expo. Please ensure that all information is included.

- Please note that the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic check box on the PAI has been removed. Any child 12 and over is considered pre-registered at the time they register their calf online.
