Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a regular or junior member of any dairy breed association, or a son/daughter of a member.
2. The above stated membership must be currently in the province of Ontario.
3. Must have successfully completed at least the first year of a University/College program and be enrolled in the following year. Applicants may have finished their fourth year and be in an Agriculture Master Program.
4. Must have returned completed application no later than June 15, 2019 to the Ontario Holstein office. No applications will be accepted after this date.
5. No individual will be eligible for a second award.
6. Unsuccessful applicants may reapply as many times as eligible.
7. Must have completed application signed by County Holstein Club President, Secretary, Youth Contact, or other Ontario Dairy Breed club officer AND 4-H leader to verify 4-H information.

Awarding of Scholarship

Eight scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled at a College/ University diploma program or a University degree program. Consideration will be given primarily to education, agricultural background, 4-H Junior Farmer involvement or other agricultural organizations, with some emphasis placed on future goals. Other accomplishments may influence the selection committee in the event of a close decision.
